

Early Childhood Australia - Preferred Provider List

Early Childhood Australia (ECA) is developing a preferred provider list. Its purpose is to enable ECA to quickly identify appropriately qualified people to undertake writing tasks for ECA which are not part of the ECA publications program.

Inclusion on the list will be for a period of two (2) years from acceptance. The list will be reviewed at the end of this period and additional inclusions may be made during the two year period.

ECA invites anyone who is interested in being on the preferred provider list to respond to the following selection criteria.

- Individual membership of ECA
- Knowledge of early childhood theory, pedagogy and practice
- Knowledge and/or experience in early childhood education and care settings
- Specialist knowledge in some aspect/s of early childhood, for example parenting, infant attachment, literacy, curriculum, management, governance and policy
- Capacity to write in plain English
- Experience of successful completion of writing projects, including research projects
- Evidence of capacity to meet tight deadlines

Each application should include two written references and the capacity to contact the references.

Applications for inclusion on the list will close on Friday 8 August 2008

Applicants will be notified of the outcome of the process by 15 August 2008
