2010 Scholarships Application Kit

To be eligible for a Scholarship you must be currently employed in the Children's Services (childcare) sector and wish to obtain a Children's Services qualification or upgrade a qualification.

Guidelines for Applicants for 2010 Scholarships

1. Scholarships are available for Children's Services Workers currently employed in the Children's Services sector as a contribution towards the costs of obtaining or upgrading a relevant approved Children's Services qualification. Scholarships will be granted up to a maximum of \$1000.

The Scholarship can only be used for:

- Course or Module Costs
- Enrolment Fee

2. A sub-committee of the ECA-TAS Branch Inc will administer the Scholarships.

All decisions of the sub-committee are final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

3. **Applicants must submit one (1) original and three (3) photocopies of their application on the official forms.**

Applicants themselves must fully complete the Scholarship application form.

All information provided by the applicant will remain confidential and will only be used for the purposes for which it was obtained.

4. **Applications must be received at PO Box 306 Sandy Bay TAS 7006 by no later than 9:30am on Monday 15 February 2010.**

To ensure receipt of the applications it is strongly suggested that all applications are submitted by registered post.

Faxed, hand delivered or emailed applications WILL NOT be accepted or considered.

5. Applicants who have previously been successful or unsuccessful in gaining a Scholarship may reapply for 2010.
6. The sub-committee may seek further information regarding the application from any source that they see fit, including an employer, and may seek an interview with an applicant if they feel it is appropriate.
7. In assessing applications for Scholarships the sub-committee will develop a rating scale taking into account the following criteria:

Priority 1: Children's Services Workers who are occupying an in-charge position requiring an approved qualification under the Standards. This applies to all Children's Services.

For example:

- Applicants with Certificate III required to gain Diploma level to continue in an in-charge position.
- FDC co-ordination staff with Social Work or Teaching qualifications that require Children's Services qualifications under the Tasmanian Licensing Standards.

Priority 2: Children's Services Workers who are occupying a position requiring an approved qualification under the Standards. This applies to all Children's Services.

For example:

- Centre-based educators who are approved to act in a qualified position and required to gain Diploma level.
- FDC educators required to gain Certificate III to maintain an extended registration under the Licensing Standards.
- FDC co-ordination staff required to gain Children's Services qualifications under the Licensing Standards.

Priority 3: EITHER:

Children's Services Workers (with the exception of those in OSHC) continuing training leading to an approved qualification under the Standards.

For example:

- FDC educators undertaking Certificate III or Diploma.
- Centre-based educators undertaking Diploma, Advanced Diploma or Degree.

OR:

OSHC educators undertaking a Certificate 1V, Diploma or Advanced Diploma.

Priority 4: Children's Services Workers currently holding an accredited qualification of two years or more who wish to further a career in Children's Services.

For example:

- Anyone with a Diploma who is planning to undertake and continue the Advanced Diploma or Degree to further their career.

8. In addition to completing the Application and Declaration Form, applicants are required to submit:

8.1 A written application of no more than 1 A4 page outlining why they feel they deserve a Scholarship. Applicants should address the following criteria:

- Ongoing commitment to Children's Services in Tasmania.
- Work history in Children's Services.
- Demonstrated ongoing commitment to study.
- Desire for career advancement.
- Desire for a deeper understanding of children's developmental needs will be taken into account.

8.2 A copy of course results if applying for a further Scholarship in 2010 and/or applying for a scholarship for the continuation of a course that is currently being undertaken.

2010 Scholarship Conditions

1. If an offer of a Scholarship is made, the offer lapses if the Scholarship recipient does not enrol within the six (6) month period from the date of the grant, unless a specific exemption from this condition is expressly granted in writing by the Scholarships sub-committee.
2. Scholarship recipients or their Employers must not be in receipt of any other training monies or scholarships for this applicant from another Organisation or Government body.
3. Scholarship recipients must have an ongoing commitment to Children's Services in Tasmania and must reside in Tasmania whilst undertaking their training under the Scholarship.
4. Should the recipient withdraw from the course, they will be required to return to ECA-TAS Branch Inc any monies paid under this scholarship program which are refunded by their Training or Course Provider.
5. A copy of course results, to prove ongoing commitment to training, may be required for progressive payments.
6. All training and study undertaken under this Scholarships scheme must be undertaken with a Registered Training Organisation or University.
7. Scholarship funds are available for reimbursement for expenses incurred from 1 January 2010 and will be automatically forfeited if not fully expended by 31 December 2011.
8. Proof of paid expenses incurred (i.e. receipts) are to be forwarded to the ECA-TAS Branch Inc Scholarship sub-committee until the approved amount has been fully expended for the purpose for which the Scholarship was granted.
9. Reimbursements for recipients costs will be made three times per year in accordance with the following schedule:
