### VALE June Wangmann

A note from our **ECA President Chris Legg.** 

Many of you will have known her, or know of her, as June played a major role in the development of quality system for children's services in Australia.

In 1992 she wrote about Accreditation: A right for all Australia's young children or a waste of time and money.

She was the former head of the Institute of Early Childhood at Macquarie University and former manager of The Office of Childcare, as well as a former Director of Community Child Care Co-operative (NSW) and was one of the strongest advocates of high quality ECE that I had the pleasure to know and, at times, work with.

June was loved by many who she taught or worked with.

### **NSW** Children's Guardian

The Children's Guardian Act is commencing 1 March 2020 and brings together existing legislation under one Act, to make the Office of the Children's Guardian (OCG) more independent and responsive.

The OCG is holding free information sessions from March 2020 about the changes and how these will affect child-related organisations.

The information sessions are designed to:

- Increase your understanding of the new Children's Guardian Act and how it impacts child-related organisations in NSW.
- Build awareness of the Child Safe Standards and understand how prevention is key to keeping children safe in organisations.

• Explain changes to the Reportable Conduct scheme and organisations need to do to comply with new requirements.






